#### CONSTRUCTION

- Materials used: infusion of polyester resin and high quality anti-osmosis resin on a balsa wood frame and fibre glass skin. Hull bottom and keel in infused monolithic laminate.
- Structural partitions (sandwich balsa) par infusion.
- Bilge painted light grey.
- Hull finished with white gel coat.
- Bridge in white gel coat with non-slip diamond plate.

# STEERING EQUIPMENT

- 2 suspended rudder blades: stainless steel spindle and foam sandwich
- Epoxy ruddertrunk tubes.
- Self-aligning upper and lower bearings.

#### **PROPULSION - ENGINE AND GEARS**
